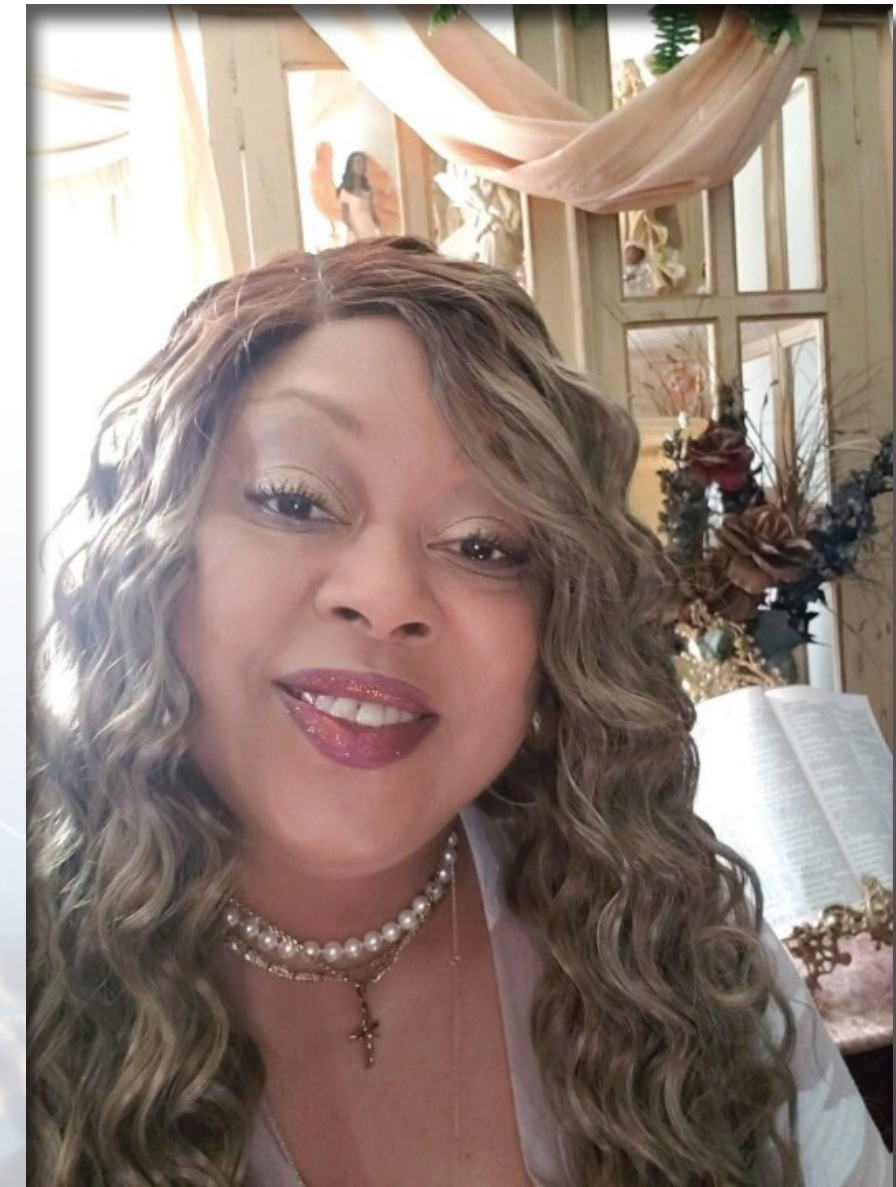

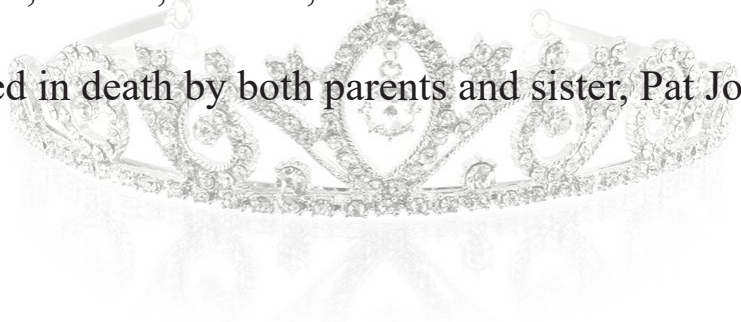
Tina Lynn Thomas, was born on March 30, 1967, in Watervally Mississippi, to the late Lonzo Peyton and Pearllean Yancy.
